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Define Goals and Objectives

- Clearly define the primary goals and objectives of the website.
- Ensure the target audience's needs are considered during the design process.
- Align the website design with the overall business objectives.
- Document the goals and objectives in the project brief or design documentation.
- How will this reduce their stress or ease the worries that keep them up at night?
- Validate the design decisions against the established goals and objectives.

Conduct Comprehensive Research

- Research the industry trends and competitors' websites thoroughly.
- Gather inspiration from various design sources, such as design galleries and portfolios.
- Take note of the design elements and functionalities that resonate with the project.
- Document the research findings and design inspiration for reference.
- Ensure the design concepts are unique and distinctive from competitors.

Plan Website Structure and Navigation

- Create a sitemap that outlines the hierarchical structure of the website.
- Define the main navigation menu and sub-navigation elements.
- Test the website structure for intuitive user flow and easy accessibility.
- Consider user experience and ensure logical grouping of related content.
- Seek feedback from colleagues or partners to validate the website structure.

Develop Wireframes and Mockups

- Create wireframes to visualize the layout and structure of each webpage.
 - Ensure the target audience's needs are considered during the design process.
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Develop Wireframes and Mockups...continued

- Validate the wireframes against the website goals and user requirements.
 - Develop mockups based on the wireframes to showcase the visual design.
 - Share the wireframes and mockups with someone you trust for honest feedback.
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Choose Appropriate Color Palette and Typography

- Select a color palette that aligns with the brand identity and target audience.
 - Ensure the colors create a harmonious and visually appealing design.
 - Test the color combinations for readability and accessibility.
 - Choose typography that enhances the readability and complements the overall design.
 - Validate the chosen colors and typography against the brand guidelines.
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Optimize Images and Media

- Compress and optimize images to reduce file sizes without sacrificing quality.
 - Ensure images are properly sized and displayed across different devices.
 - Optimize media files, such as videos or audio, for fast loading times.
 - Test image and media loading speed and make necessary optimizations.
 - Use appropriate image formats (JPEG, PNG, GIF) based on the content and purpose.
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Design Engaging Call-to-Action (CTA) Buttons

- Ensure CTAs are visually prominent and stand out from the rest of the design.
 - Use clear and compelling language in the CTAs to encourage user interaction.
 - Test the responsiveness and functionality of CTAs on different devices and browsers.
 - Ensure CTAs are strategically placed throughout the website for maximum visibility.
 - Validate that CTAs direct users to the correct destination or action.
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Ensure Responsive Design

- Test the website on various devices and screen sizes to ensure responsiveness.
- Check that all elements, (images, text, navigation etc.) adapt well to different screens.
- Validate that the website is mobile-friendly and provides a seamless user experience.
- Test and adjust the design to ensure consistency and readability across devices.

Optimize Website Speed and Performance

- Run website speed tests in the Wix dashboard.
- Identify and address performance issues.

Test Cross-Browser Compatibility

- Test the website on major browsers (Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Edge, etc.).
- Check for consistency in design, layout, and functionality across different browsers.
- Address any rendering or functionality issues specific to certain browsers.

Implement Seo Best Practices

- Conduct keyword research to identify relevant keywords for each webpage.
- Optimize meta tags, including title tags and meta descriptions, with targeted keywords.
- Create unique and descriptive URLs for each page.
- Ensure proper heading structure (H1, H2, etc.) and use relevant keywords.
- Optimize image alt tags and include keyword-rich content.

Perform Usability Testing

- Conduct usability tests with users (friends, family, colleagues, etc....) to gather feedback.
 - Observe how users navigate the website and identify any usability issues.
 - Test the website's forms, interactive elements, and user flows.
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Perform Usability Testing...continued

- Analyze user feedback and make necessary improvements to enhance usability.
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Integrate Analytics

- Set up web analytics tools or use the tools provided in the Wix dashboard.
 - Identify and address issues.
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Secure Website

- Include a privacy policy and cookie consent notice, if applicable.
 - Secure sensitive data, such as user information and payment details, if applicable.
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Integrate Social Media

- Include social media sharing buttons to encourage content sharing.
 - Implement social media follow buttons to promote social media profiles.
 - Ensure the buttons are visually appealing and easily recognizable.
 - Test the functionality of the social media buttons across different platforms
 - Customize the buttons to match the overall design and branding.
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Accessibility Compliance

- Test the website for accessibility compliance, following WCAG guidelines. Use the Wix Accessibility Tool in the Editor.
 - Ensure proper use of alt tags for images and provide text alternatives for non-text content.
 - Use proper heading structure and semantic HTML markup.
 - Test the website with assistive technologies, such as screen readers.
 - Make necessary adjustments to ensure accessibility for users with disabilities.
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Prepare For Launch

- Conduct thorough quality assurance testing to catch any remaining issues.
 - Remove any test or placeholder content and ensure all pages are populated.
 - Create a launch plan and schedule, including communication and promotion strategies.
